

Cattail



Cattails are native plants that grow in wetlands. They are one of the most common plants in marshes and on the edges of ponds. The cattails produce an abundance of wind-dispersed seeds and they will also spread by rhizomes to rapidly colonize an area.

Cattails are important to wildlife for food, foraging and protection. Many parts of the plants are edible to humans.
