

OVERALL ANALYSIS

Mean Scores:

All Completers (PK-12): 96.13%, Elementary (PK-5): 96.27%, Secondary (6-12): 96.80%

Key Observations:

- 1. Manage and Crit Thnk: Secondary (6-12) scored higher (100%) compared to All Completers (PK-12) and Elementary (PK-5).
- 2. **Assm Eth** and **Assm Data**: Elementary (PK-5) scored higher in **Assm Eth** (100%) compared to All Completers (PK-12) and Secondary (6-12). However, Secondary (6-12) scored lower in **Assm Data** (88%) compared to All Completers (PK-12) and Elementary (PK-5).
- 3. Inst Strg: Elementary (PK-5) scored higher (100%) compared to All Completers (PK-12) and Secondary (6-12).

Overall, Secondary (6-12) had the highest mean score across the indicators, followed closely by Elementary (PK-5) and All Completers (PK-12).

FOCUS ON ASSESSMENT INDICATORS

Mean Scores:

All Completers (PK-12): 89.67%, Elementary (PK-5): 92.00%, Secondary (6-12): 88.00%

Key Observations:

- 1. **Assm Mthd**: Secondary (6-12) scored higher (88%) compared to All Completers (PK-12) and Elementary (PK-5).
- 2. Assm Eth: Elementary (PK-5) scored the highest (100%) compared to All Completers (PK-12) and Secondary (6-12).
- 3. Assm Data: Elementary (PK-5) scored higher (92%) compared to All Completers (PK-12) and Secondary (6-12).

Overall, Elementary (PK-5) had the highest mean score across the ASSM indicators, followed by All Completers (PK-12) and Secondary (6-12).




